Itinerary Changes

Atlantis and Royal Caribbean have carefully planned this itinerary for maximum enjoyment in all our ports and onboard your ship. Although we do our best to adhere to published ports and times, unforeseen weather and/or sea conditions may force us to alter the itinerary during your cruise.

In the unlikely event of an itinerary change while sailing, we will communicate our new plan both through ship wide (outside of cabin) announcements and through an updated Cruise Compass. Neither Atlantis nor Royal Caribbean shall be held liable for any damages resulting from any itinerary change according to your Passenger Cruise Contract.

Do This Right Now

Review Your Passport or Proof of Citizenship Documents

In order to travel, a valid passport is preferred and required for all guests from outside the U.S.A. Proof of citizenship in the form of an original birth certificate and a government issued photo ID is acceptable for U.S. citizens only. Visas are not required for citizens of the US and Canada. Visa requirements for all other nationalities vary and should be checked with the embassy or consulate of each country visited on your itinerary.

Please note that it is your responsibility to have the necessary documentation before boarding the ship. Failure to provide proper and valid documentation will result in denied boarding, and no refund will be provided.

Register On-line With Royal Caribbean Line (RCI)

Please take a minute now to register online with Royal Caribbean as it is essential this year to upload your vaccination documentation immediately. It only takes a minute, and you can start at the following link:

If you don't have one yet, you'll need to set up an account with Royal Caribbean. Additionally, you'll need to download the Royal Caribbean app to your mobile phone in order to complete the check-in process. Once you complete the online registration, the final details will remain in the app on your phone.

To Check-in, you will need:

- Royal Caribbean Booking Number (same for all guests in each stateroom)
- Full legal name as Atlantis has it recorded
- Your Passport information
- Credit card to use for onboard purchases

For Online Check-In Assistance, please contact RCI at 866-562-7625.

If you are unable to complete online check-in, you will be required to complete check-in at the pier. It just might take a bit longer to process and get you onboard.

COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements

Due to the social nature of an Atlantis events, we highly recommend all guest have been vaccinated and boosted against COVID-19 before sailing. The crew is 100% vaccinated.

Atlantis is no longer requiring proof of vaccination but please consider it to protect yourself and others. Additionally, if you are quarantined due to COVID-19 symptoms and/or test results onboard you will not receive any compensation for lost travel time and/or additional costs. We highly recommend Travel Insurance to

cover these unexpected circumstances.

Review your Flight Plans

This sounds obvious, but take a minute right now and make sure that your flights are booked correctly to Ft. Lauderdale.

Make sure you have enough time to depart correctly from the ship on February 12 as well. Your flight should not be booked before 11 am from Ft Lauderdale and no earlier than noon if you're flying from Miami.

Update on Shore Excursions

Atlantis has worked closely with RCI to enhance and develop shore excursions that will be fun and exciting for our group. Virtually all of these excursions are "exclusive" to Atlantis guests, although in a very few cases the tours may be mixed with guests from other cruise ships. If you are in doubt, please inquire with Shore Excursions before booking.

Show Tickets and Bookings

We are currently loading our entertainment program into the Royal Caribbean application, which you can use to book reservations for most of our shows once onboard. Many of our shows are ticketed, so take some time upon embarkation to review the week's schedule and book accordingly. Some shows will undoubtedly be in high demand, so we strongly encourage planning ahead

We will be monitoring show reservations closely on the first day and if needed will add performances of our popular shows.

Before You Depart

Packing Advice

Atlantis emphasizes a casual, relaxed atmosphere with no specified dress code. Sportswear and casual resort attire are appropriate at all times. There are no formal nights, and absolutely no need for a jacket and tie.

Our only real rule is that no tank tops are worn in any of the specialty restaurants at dinner. Please respect this rule for our premium dining experiences for all guests. The staff at these restaurants will ask you to change.

Plan for warm, even hot weather with slightly cooler breezes at night. We recommend loose, comfortable cottons and other lightweight clothing. Don't forget a hat!

Our ports are beach resorts with no specific dress requirements. We suggest casual beach wear and some really comfortable shoes. Some tours involve long bus rides and/or considerable walking so comfort is essential.

Daytime at sea is time for swim wear and flip flops. Bring lots of sunblock.

Atlantis Theme Parties

Atlantis theme parties are legendary and dressing up is part of the show, but is of course always optional. You'll be comfortable with or without an outfit. All parties will be in the AquaTheater, or in the Solarium.

- **Disco Daze T-Dance** -Disco lives on as we take you back to the glory days of the late 70s for an afternoon of pure musical magic on the dance floor. Artificial fabrics, excess facial hair, oversized shoes, and other obnoxious accessories welcome!
- **Mother Earth** Our planet needs some love and care, so tonight, we celebrate the beauty of the elements around us: Fire, Water, Earth, Sky. Be a literal element or a person that's surrounded by one, or just come as an original citizen of the world! Let's try to cool down Mother Earth with some creativity and craziness.

- Into the Jungle We're going deep tonight into uncharted territory, where things are as wild as it gets. In the only jungle at sea, you'll find scantily clad native wannabees, dangerous animal prints, hunters without mobile services, and maybe some strangely moving foliage. And yes, there are plenty of other parties onboard, but no need to dress specifically for them!

Prohibited Items

Please do not bring any of the following onboard, and do not place these items in your checked luggage: Irons (including travel irons), alcoholic beverages, knives, firearms, or any other potentially dangerous item.

If your luggage contains any of the above items, your bag will be held at security and will not be delivered to your stateroom. Full details on prohibited items can be found on the Royal Caribbean website.

Currency Advice

The entire ship operates on U.S. Dollars. Both Aruba and Curacao have currencies pegged to the US dollar and readily accept US dollars.

There is absolutely no need to exchange money or bring local currency.

And always select the "local currency" option when making purchases to avoid transaction fees.

Baggage Essentials

Most airlines, especially non-US airlines, limit checked bags and carry-on luggage. Check with your carrier for specific allowances. The standard limit is 50 pounds (23 kilos) per piece. Excess or overweight bags may incur a substantial surcharge, so please plan accordingly.

There are no weight limits or bag fees for the cruise itself.

Embarkation Day!

Getting to the Port in Ft Lauderdale

The easiest way to get to the port is by taxi or ride-sharing (Uber, Lyft, etc.), all of which are readily available at the Ft Lauderdale airport. The port is a 10-minute cab ride from the airport, and costs about \$25, depending on the service.

Covered parking is available for a rate of \$15.00 per day at the pier. Nearby services may be cheaper.

There is only one cruise ship port in Ft. Lauderdale and it's called Port Everglades. The address is:

We will be docked at terminal 18.

Important Check-In Information - Please Read!

The ship will open for embarkation beginning around noon, and we'll start check-in around 11:00 am. While the terminal is very large and efficient, remember that we have to process 5000 guests. Please do not arrive earlier than your scheduled time as we need time to turn the ship around after the previous sailing.

When you register online, you'll be able to select an arrival window. Please adhere to the arrival window on your SetSail pass in order to keep crowding in the terminal at a minimum. Guests arriving on time will be given priority over guests who arrive earlier than scheduled.

Due to government regulations requiring cruise lines to submit final departure manifests at least 60 minutes prior to sailing, guests are requested to complete Online Check-in no later than 3 days prior to their cruise. If you have not completed Online Check-in, you will be required to complete this process at the pier at least 90 minutes prior to the published sailing time.

Please note that you must be at the pier and checked in no later than 3:30 pm or you may be denied boarding.

Harmony of the Seas sails at 4:30pm sharp on February 4.

What Do I Need to Check-In?

Since your reservation is electronic, all you need is valid passport and a valid credit card to check-in for this cruise. When you arrive at your room you'll find your SeaPass card, which will serve as your room key and identification card for boarding and re-boarding the ship!

Alcoholic Beverage and Other Restrictions

Guests are not allowed to bring beer or hard liquor onboard for consumption or any other use on boarding day or while in port. Alcoholic beverages seized on boarding day will not be returned.

Guests wishing to bring personal wine and champagne onboard may do so only on boarding day, limited to two (2) 750 ml bottles per stateroom. When consumed in a public area, each bottle shall be subject to a corkage fee. Additional bottles of wine beyond two (2) bottles that are brought onboard or any alcoholic beverages purchased in ports of call or from Shops On Board will be stored by the ship and delivered to your stateroom on the last day of the sailing

Security may inspect containers (water bottles, soda bottles, mouthwash, luggage etc.) and will dispose of containers holding alcohol. Guests who violate any alcohol policies, may be disembarked or not allowed to board, at their own expense, in accordance with the Royal Caribbean Guest Conduct Policy.

Lost Luggage Assistance

If your luggage does not arrive with you, please do all of the following:

- 1.Get a complete report from the airline, including a receipt and tracking number for your luggage. Make sure that you tell the airline that you are boarding Harmony of the Seas.
- 2. Upon arrival on the ship, go immediately to guest services where they will make a copy of your lost baggage report. The ship will attempt to track your luggage and follow up directly with the airlines.
- 3. Be patient. Depending on the airline it might arrive prior to sailing. Our port agents, in concert with the ship, will attempt to deliver any lost luggage directly to your room. If your luggage does not arrive, they will keep you informed with the latest news from your airline.

Please understand that neither RCI nor Atlantis has lost your luggage. We can only assist you in recovering your luggage from the airline and in communicating with them. Ultimately, the airline is responsible to you for any loss or inconvenience you encounter.

However, in our experience most bags turn up in the first 48 hours.

Atlantis Daily Program

The Atlantis version of the Harmony of the Seas daily program, called *Cruise Compass* will be delivered to your stateroom each night with a complete schedule for the following day. Since this is our primary method of communicating with you, please read it daily. Changes and/or updates from our original schedule are common during a cruise.

Even better, all our events can be found in the Royal Caribbean app.

If you don't feel like reading, take 5 minutes each morning to watch Malcolm's daily TV broadcast for a more entertaining look at the upcoming day's events. You can find this on your stateroom television.

Team & Information Desk

Our office and volunteer Team Atlantis staff will be on hand throughout to host and assist with every aspect of your vacation. Please don't hesitate to ask any of us if you have a question or require assistance. We are available 24 hours a day, and always wear Atlantis name badges.

We also offer a general information desk located adjacent to Guest Services on Deck 5. Hours vary and are posted in Cruise Compass.

Atlantis staff can also be reached through Guest Services at any time.

How it Works

Atlantis and Royal Caribbean are presenting more productions, acts, and cabaret shows this week than ever before. Instead of one major theater space, we now have three. On any given night you might see a show in the Royal Theater, Aqua Theater, or Studio B.

We repeat all our performances enough to accommodate virtually everyone. While it's possible to see every performance offered during the week, we've designed more shows than nights and more entertainment to cover more tastes than ever before.

We recommend planning your week with your friends prior to making any show reservations. It's much easier to do it all at once than make a lot of changes during the cruise.

Show Reservations and Tickets

In order to control our capacities and help you plan your cruise, the main venues will use electronic ticketing for most performances. All shows are, of course, free. There is no physical ticket -- your SeaPass card serves as your electronic entry and is scanned at our doors. You'll have a guaranteed space up until 10 minutes prior to showtime. Making a reservation is easy and can be done once you're onboard using the Royal Caribbean Mobile App or by visiting our in-person Box Office.

All dining times are approximate, and may change slightly according to our port times and onboard events.

Team Atlantis will be on hand at the main restaurant to seat you, answer questions, and host tables. We always encourage you to join our other guests for meals. It's the best way to meet people! Both Atlantis and Royal will do our best to honor special seating requests. Note that we seat one deck at a time.

Please be patient during peak hours as there may be a slight wait in the main restaurants. We recommend dining before 8:00pm or after 9:00pm to avoid waiting in line. The best way to avoid waiting in line is to either dine before the first show or immediately afterwards.

What's Included?

Most meals and restaurants are included. The exceptions are specialty restaurants in the section below. Coffee, tea, and most juices are also included. Specialty coffees, alcoholic beverages, soft drinks, bottled water are available at our bars and restaurants for an additional charge.

While some of you enjoy a relaxed dinner every night, many of you never get past the Windjammer. And that's a shame, since you paid for a premium experience in our restaurants! Dinner can be as quick or long as you wish and there's no better way to meet our other guests than at a table in our main restaurants.

We suggest taking advantage of dining in a variety of venues and enjoying your meal times with friends old and new. It's the easiest way to connect!

Specialty Restaurants & Reservations

Harmony offers several distinctive and original dining experiences. Chops is an authentic steak house, with a warm clubby decor, Jamie's Italian features superb Italian food from celebrity chef Jamie Oliver. The jewel box 150 Central Park offers delicious farm-to-table options. Izumi offers sushi and teppanyaki in an inviting setting. Sabor offers modern Mexican all day. Wonderland is the ultimate food adventure with a little magic thrown in.

Reservations are strongly encouraged, and a limited number of bookings may be made in advance when you register online. We will hold approximately 30% of the seats for same-day bookings to allow flexibility for all guests.

Additionally, Royal Caribbean is offering some exceptional values on dining "packages" that allow you to eat big and save bigger with special deals on specialty restaurant experiences. See the cruise planner for details and we recommend booking in advance since offerings are limited.

For same day dining reservations, these must be made in person, and only one reservation per stateroom will be accepted daily. The specialty restaurants are not equipped to handle parties larger than eight guests (and only a few tables are this size). Please respect these policies so that the maximum number of our guests may enjoy these unique dining experiences.

Finally, please respect that we have limited space in these restaurants and a lot of guests want to enjoy them. If your plans change, please cancel your booking in a timely manner so that we can accommodate another guest. Also, please respect your original request in terms of table size (don't show up with 8 guests when you book for 4!). Thank you.

Tank tops and gym-like shorts are not permitted in these premium restaurants and we ask that you please respect this simple dress code.

An extra charge for dining applies in each venue, including gratuity.

Singles Dining

Traveling solo doesn't mean you have to eat alone. Whenever you enter our restaurants, our Team Atlantis will graciously seat you with our other guests. We've also created a designated meeting place for single guests to gather for drinks before dinner. See Cruise Compass for specific times and locations.

Room Service

Room service is available 24 hours a day. See the menu in your stateroom for a complete selection and ordering instructions, and note that some specialty selections and delivery times have an extra charge. Please recognize that the staff handling room service has limited capabilities. If you're looking for a quick snack, we highly recommend Cafe Promenade, open 24 hours a day.

Special Diets

We ask that you submit any special dietary requests including allergies in writing directly to Royal Caribbean prior to sailing. Once onboard, please speak with the Maitre D' of the restaurant regarding any special requests.

Please note that since this cruise is "open seating," it is your responsibility to notify the server and/or Maitre D' of any special requests each time you dine.

Vegetarian options are available at each meal and need no advance notification.

Optional Beverage Packages

Royal Caribbean offers some great non-alcoholic beverage packages on our charter. This package can be booked in advance when you pre-register online.

Beverage packages may also be purchased onboard at the designated tables on embarkation day or at any of the non-satellite bars.

Please note that unlimited alcohol packages are not offered on charter sailings and that the packages offered might be different from a standard sailing.

Drink Ticket Packages

Royal Caribbean is offering a special discounted "drink ticket" package to Atlantis guests, with books of 20 tickets available for \$225. Drink tickets are valid for any alcoholic drink up to \$14 (which is most everything) or for two non-alcoholic beverages (if picked up at same time).

A few other minor restrictions apply as follows:

One alcoholic beverage per coupon. Beverages include spirits, cocktails, wine by the glass, beer.

All espresso based and specialty coffee are excluded. No beverages from Cafe Promenade or Starbucks.

Coupons cannot be applied to any beverage over \$14

18% gratuity is added to the purchase price. VAT or taxes might be added based on itinerary or ports.

Unused or lost coupons will not be refunded.

Seapass card needs to be presented at the time of redemption

Drink tickets may be purchased through the Atlantis reservation system until February 1. See the "Already Booked" page of our website for directions.

Pre-purchased drink ticket packages may be picked up upon embarkation. You'll need either your SetSail Pass or room key to pick up your packages. We recommend picking them up as soon as you board to save time and running around!.

Onboard Harmony of the Seas

Personal Funds & Shipboard Charges

The currency onboard is U.S. dollars. Royal Caribbean ships operate on a cashless system. You can validate your Royal Caribbean *SeaPass* card with your Visa, MasterCard, Discover/Novus, or American Express card, or sign for payment by cash or traveler's check. Guests can then sign all onboard services and purchases to their account. At the end of the cruise, you will receive a completely itemized statement.

For your convenience, the ship has an onboard ATM machine that dispenses U.S. currency. Bank debit cards on the PLUS and CIRRUS networks are accepted along with the following credit cards: American Express, Discover/Novus, MasterCard and VISA. Fees will be charged per transaction.

Room Features

The rooms on the Harmony of the Seas are truly state-of-the art, with a few features not found on other ships. The ship has both 110 (US standard) and 220/230 (European) voltage power outlets in the rooms. All the water onboard is filtered and potable.

Each stateroom is equipped with an in-room safe, private bath with shower and vanity area, hair dryer and interactive TV and movies and phone.

The interactive TV system offers a wide range of on-demand movies, as well as Atlantis programming and popular satellite channels. In addition, you can review your account, order room service. We recommend familiarizing yourself with this system when you embark as it can save hours of standing in line!

Customs & Immigration at Sea

Upon embarkation and at each port of call, customs and immigration officials will inspect our guests and the ship. They must clear it before we are allowed to go ashore. Normally, this occurs without your knowledge or participation. Occasionally, passengers are called for inspection. In these cases, please follow the instructions provided to assure that we are able to disembark in a timely manner in each port.

While we shouldn't have to say this, please don't even think of bringing any type of illegal substance, hazardous material, or other items that are banned by customs or ship security. Any guest found with illegal substances of any kind will be removed from the ship at the next port of call and turned over to local authorities.

Atlantis and RCI both have a zero-tolerance policy for all illegal substances.

Guest Conduct Policy

Please remember that all our guests are bound by Royal Caribbean's Guest Conduct Policy. The policy is intended to help ensure that all guests are able to participate in a safe and enjoyable cruise experience and sets forth standards of conduct for guests to follow throughout their vacation. Laundry & Dry Cleaning Services

Laundry, dry cleaning, spot removal and pressing services are available for an additional fee. Laundry bags and service request forms are in your room. Ask your cabin steward for details.

There are no irons in staterooms as they constitute a fire hazard. There are also no self-service laundry facilities onboard.

Gratuities and Tipping

All standard gratuities have been prepaid for this week, so there is no tipping required or expected at any time. All cabin stewards, waiters, and other personnel have been compensated at levels that are customary for a charter of this size. No additional tipping to these service personnel is needed but may be extended at your discretion if the service is exceptional.

An 18% mandatory gratuity is automatically added to bar purchases and spa services.

Smoking Policy

For the comfort of all of our guests, all indoor areas on the ship are non-smoking. Smoking is permitted only in designated outdoor areas of the starboard/or port side of the ship. As a courtesy to our guests, ship personnel will thoroughly enforce the smoking policy.

No smoking is allowed in Central Park or the Boardwalk neighborhoods at any time as well. Smoking is never allowed on any stateroom balcony.

Please note that Atlantis and/or RCI reserves the right to change the smoking policy at any time depending on guest requirements. A complete detail of the smoking areas onboard can be found in your stateroom upon embarkation in the *Cruise Compass*.

Suite Class Amenities

All guests in a Grand Suite or higher category will be entitled to several unique and valuable VIP services on Harmony. Full details will be provided upon embarkation, but here are a few of the highlights:

- **Suite Lounge Access**. You'll have exclusive access to the fabulous concierge lounge on deck 17, with the best view of the pools for breakfast, lunch, and evening cocktails. Our trained concierges will assist you with virtually all of your reservation needs, including restaurants and shows.
- Coastal Kitchen Private Dining. Enjoy the best view on the ship accompanied by a fresh Mediterranean menu for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. This exclusive restaurant is only available to our suite guests. Hours are posted in the *Cruise Compass*. Junior suites also have access to Coastal Kitchen.
- **Priority Seating for Main Shows**. There's no need to reserve show tickets, just show your suite card up to 10 minutes prior to showtime and you'll walk right in! Please note that we hold limited priority seating for our suite guests up until 15 minutes before the show starts.
- Advance Specialty Restaurant Reservations. Each suite room is allowed to make up to 3 advance bookings for this cruise at our specialty restaurants. See the Concierge for assistance.

If You Have a Problem or Question

Both the Guest Services Desk and the Atlantis Information Desk can handle most any difficulty you may encounter. Generally, issues relating to your stateroom, the ship, schedules, or billing should be directed to the Guest Relations Desk. Questions regarding entertainment, service, Atlantis policies, special requests, or anything else should be directed to the Atlantis Desk. Questions about excursions should go directly to the Shore Excursions Desk, Deck 6.

If the Atlantis Desk is unattended, please feel free to ask any Team Atlantis member and we will happily assist you.

Spa Services

Harmony features an exceptional full-service spa, offering a fantastic range of services including massage, facial, aromatherapy, hairstyling, and much more. Appointments for these services should be made early in your cruise, as many of the services book up early. All spa services are an additional charge which can be signed to your stateroom.

You can book spa appointments for all our port days online now. Spa appointments for our sea day will be available on Saturday afternoon, immediately following the boat drill. The spa will be open earlier that day for tours and same-day appointments.

Medical Services

Should you require medical attention while on board, an infirmary staff is available to assist you 24 hours a day. A doctor is available to render services at a customary charge. The infirmary is capable of providing treatment for minor matters which may arise during your cruise and are capable of assessing and stabilizing most medical emergencies. Should you require treatment for a serious condition which requires hospitalization, then arrangements may be made to transfer you to a medical facility ashore. While at sea, the ability to transfer you to a shore side facility may be limited or delayed by weather or logistical considerations. If you are currently suffering from a serious medical condition, please consult with your personal physician prior to sailing. Royal Caribbean's doctors are independent contractors.

Please note that all Medical Services onboard are provided by a contractor and will carry a substantial extra charge. This charge is often covered by Travel Insurance but might not be covered by your local health insurance. We highly recommend reviewing your coverage before traveling.

Important Health Notice -- Please Read!

If you should come down with a contagious disease, or even suspect a contagious disease, it's compulsory that you report it to the ship's infirmary for the safety of everyone on board. Particularly given the current COVID pandemic, it is especially important that you comply with this regulation for the safety of everyone onboard. Should you be on any medication, or want the medical staff to be aware of any special needs, please contact the infirmary. This will ensure that they will be prepared should you need assistance.

In rare instances, the ship's medical staff may determine that your medical condition will require you to be quarantined in your stateroom to protect the health of our other guests. While both RCI and Atlantis will make every effort to make you comfortable in such a situation, we are unable to compensate lost vacation time due to quarantine, including for COVID quarantines.

Please note that the ship follows C.D.C. guidelines on all quarantine issues, and there is little flexibility in applying the rules.

As always, we highly recommend travel insurance to assist with unforeseen costs and reimbursement for missed vacation time due to illness of any type. If you do not have travel insurance, it can be purchased virtually right up to departure time.

Safety At Sea

Atlantis and Royal Caribbean want you to have lots of fun in a safe and enjoyable environment throughout your journey onboard *Harmony of the Seas*. Given the large numbers of people enjoying our parties and events, we've decided to bring some additional team members to supplement the superb onboard staff of *Harmony*.

Care Team

Our Care Team is here to help! At all our parties and events you'll find a team of dedicated medical professionals here to assist with absolutely anything. They will be wearing bright blue T-shirts with our Care Team logo and all have experience in working large festivals, sports events, and nightlife.

If you or anybody around you needs assistance or might need medical care, please simply ask them. They are here to help and will provide support in a non-judgmental manner regardless of the situation. All matters are handled in the same ethical manner as in a land-based hospital.

Most importantly, please look after yourselves and each other. If you see somebody who over-indulged or is unwell, please let our team assist first.

Enjoy yourselves, but remember to take breaks to eat, sleep, and of course hydrate! Most people don't realize how different being at sea is and how the combination of motion, sun, and late hours can sneak up on you. Take a night off once and a while and explore the myriad of options we have planned for you!

You are here on vacation, and we truly want you to go home feeling rested, not exhausted.

After Your Cruise

Arrival into Ft Lauderdale

Upon arriving into Ft Lauderdale after your cruise, we will begin disembarkation around 7am. This procedure generally takes two hours. If you have a flight earlier than 11am, please notify Royal Caribbean onboard and we'll do our best to prioritize your departure.

After leaving the ship you may claim your luggage on the pier. Baggage lost or damaged must be reported to Royal Caribbean prior to leaving baggage claim.

Satellite Telephone Access

You can make ship-to-shore calls from your stateroom, 24 hours a day. A per minute charge applies and will automatically be charged to your *SeaPass* account.

Internet Access – VOOM Powered by Starlink

Harmony offers the fastest ship-wide internet access at sea for an additional fee. Every stateroom has wireless access, as do virtually all public areas throughout the ship. Connection fees apply with a range of packages available either in advance or onboard. VOOM is amazing, and you won't know you're even at sea!

Cell Phone Access Onboard

Harmony is equipped to allow your mobile phone to work onboard. Please note that roaming charges apply, and will be billed directly by your home carrier. Rates vary by carrier, but are considerably cheaper than using the satellite phones. Check with your carrier prior to sailing for specific rates.

This access only works while at sea. When in port, the local land operator's roaming charges will apply. Again, check with your operator to see what roaming options exist.

We highly recommend turning off data while at sea and placing your phone in "airplane mode" to avoid unexpected and substantial charges.
