Please note that all arrival and departure times are approximate and may change without notice. Also, the times listed here are slightly different than what was originally published on the Atlantis web site. The times above are correct.

Itinerary Changes

Atlantis and NCL (Norwegian Cruise Line) have carefully planned this itinerary for maximum enjoyment in all our ports and onboard your ship. Although we do our best to adhere to published ports and times, unforeseen weather and/or sea conditions may force us to alter the itinerary during your cruise.

In the unlikely event of an itinerary change while sailing, we will communicate our new plan both through ship wide (outside of cabin) announcements and through an updated *Freestyle Daily* (NCL's daily onboard newsletter). Neither Atlantis nor NCL shall be held liable for any damages resulting from any itinerary change according to your Passenger Cruise Contract.

Do This Right Now

Review Your Passport or Proof of Citizenship Documents

In order to travel, a valid passport is preferred and required for all guests from outside the U.S.A. Proof of citizenship in the form of an original birth certificate and a government issued photo ID is acceptable for U.S. citizens only. Visas are not required for citizens of the US and Canada. Visa requirements for all other nationalities vary and should be checked with the embassy or consulate of each country visited on your itinerary.

Please note that it is your responsibility to have the necessary documentation before boarding the ship. Failure to provide proper and valid documentation will result in denied boarding, and no refund will be provided.

Register Online To Download Your Travel Documents

This year, it's more important than ever to check-in online early. The safety drill is a "virtual event" that you complete during the check-in process and all guests must have completed it prior to embarkation.

Please take a time now to register online with NCL. It only takes a few minutes and you can start at the following link: <https://www.ncl.com/>

Click on the "Manage" tab on the upper right part of the page and then select "check-in". You'll have to create an account with NCL if you don't already have one. Once you complete the online registration, you should print your Cruise Documents and hang onto them to bring to the pier on the 22nd. Before you start registration, please note the following in the "Explore" and "Plan" section of registration is either incorrect or are different for a charter sailing:

Please note that your NCL Booking Number is not the same as your Atlantis Confirmation Number and each room has only one NCL Booking Number assigned. Should you encounter any issues registering with NCL, please contact them directly at 866-234-7350 as Atlantis doesn't have control over this system.

If you are not able to successfully pre-register, please do not worry, as it will not affect your booking status or ability to board.

Please note that you must complete the registration process by January 18. After that time you can register at the pier.

COVID-19 Vaccination Requirements

Due to the social nature of an Atlantis events, all guests must present proof of COVID-19 vaccination in order to sail. Vaccines authorized by the USA, Canada, and EU will be accepted and you must have received your last dose before January 18. The crew is 100% vaccinated.

If you have not received a booster (3rd dose or beyond), you will be required to provide a negative test result for a test (antigen or PCR) taken on or after January 19.

Atlantis highly recommends getting the "new" bivalent booster to protect yourself and others during our experience. Even if you get it last-minute there will be some benefit.

Guests without proper proof of vaccination or test results will be denied boarding and no refund will be offered.

Review your Flight Plans

This sounds obvious, but take a minute right now and make sure that your flights are booked correctly to Orlando.

Make sure you have enough time to depart correctly from the ship on January 29 as well. Your flight should not be booked before 11 am.

Book Shore Excursions Now

You can pre-book shore excursions in advance on the NCL website (<https://www.ncl.com>) until January 18. Upon arrival to the ship, you will receive tickets for your pre-booked excursions in your stateroom.

We understand that several of you have had issues with the NCL system and apologize for the shortcomings. Most of the issues have been fixed and NCL will work with all guests to make sure that you get the packages purchased when you arrive.

You may purchase additional shore excursions onboard, subject to availability, at the Shore Excursions Desk. You may also book shore excursions through your TV set using the interactive system in your room.

Atlantis has worked closely with NCL to enhance and develop shore excursions that will be fun and exciting for our group. Virtually all of these excursions are "exclusive" to Atlantis guests, although in a very few cases the tours may be mixed with guests from other cruise ships. If you are in doubt, please inquire with Shore Excursions before booking.

Before You Depart

Packing Advice

Atlantis emphasizes a casual, relaxed atmosphere with no specified dress code. Sportswear and casual resort attire are always appropriate. There are no formal nights, and absolutely no need for a jacket and tie.

Our only real rule is that no tank tops or shorts are permitted in any of the specialty restaurants at dinner. Please respect this rule for our premium dining experiences for all guests. The staff at these restaurants will ask you to change.

Plan for warm, even hot weather with slightly cooler breezes at night. We recommend loose, comfortable cottons and other lightweight clothing. Don't forget a hat!

Our ports are beach resorts with no specific dress requirements. We suggest casual beach wear and some comfortable shoes. Some tours involve long bus rides and/or considerable walking so comfort is essential.

Daytime at sea is time for swim wear and flip flops. Bring lots of sunblock.

Atlantis Party Themes

Our theme parties are legendary and dressing up is part of the show but is of course always optional. You'll be comfortable with or without an outfit. This cruise presents a few challenges since we will be in very different climates throughout and most of you don't want to drag a lot of costumes around the planet. With that in mind, we're keeping things simple but fabulous!

We're planning to present the T-dances outdoors on the Pool Deck, weather permitting.

Dog Tag T-Dance - The troops come home for Atlantis' longest-running signature afternoon party. Show your creative strength at our first big outdoor party inspired by the joys of men in (small) uniforms. We'll provide souvenir dog tags, you do the rest.

Over the Rainbow T-Dance - This one isn't just about Dorothy or a scary multicolor tube-top from Pride. But that's a start. Show up as a singular color from your own personal rainbow, an Oz-like inspiration, or the worst combination of colors you can pull together.

Mother Earth - Our planet needs some love and care, so tonight, we celebrate the beauty of the elements around us: Fire, Water, Earth, Sky. Be a literal element or a person that's surrounded by one, or just come as an original citizen of the world! Let's try to cool down Mother Earth with some creativity and craziness.

Disco Daze T-Dance - Disco lives on as we take you back to the glory days of the late 70s for an afternoon of pure musical magic on the dance floor. Artificial fabrics, excess facial hair, oversized shoes, and other obnoxious accessories welcome!

Into the Jungle - We're going deep tonight into uncharted territory, where things are as wild as it gets. In the only jungle at sea, you'll find scantily clad native wannabees, dangerous animal prints, hunters without mobile services, and maybe some strangely moving foliage. Follow the beats to the dance floor and watch out for the occasional castaway cruise ship passenger.

Playground - Fast, flashy, bright, and silly! We're turning the Theater into a musical playground filled with bouncy sounds that are sure to bring a smile to your face. Neon, sparkles, and lights are the way to go tonight, and don't take anything too seriously!

White Dreams - Our community is as diverse it gets, but this week we're one tribe here to have fun and come together to play for a few magical days at sea. All are welcome here as we celebrate together at an epic party that takes you into dawn and beyond!

And yes, there are plenty of other parties onboard, but no need to dress specifically for them!

Currency Advice

The entire ship operates on U.S. Dollars and only in Mexico will you possibly need to use local currency. The current rate of exchange is:

Mexican Peso (MXN) \$1 USD = \$MXN 18.76

Virtually everywhere we visit has cashless options, but having some cash on hand is useful and ultimately US Dollars are accepted at all our ports.

If you do need to exchange money we strongly recommend using your ATM card to get the best rate, just be wary of bank fees. There are plenty of ATM machines throughout our ports. You'll also get the best exchange by using a credit card for large purchases. Always select the "local currency" option when making purchases to avoid transaction fees.

Baggage Essentials

Most airlines, especially non-US airlines, limit checked bags and carry-on luggage. Check with your carrier for specific allowances. The standard limit is 50 pounds (23 kilos) per piece. Excess or overweight bags may incur a substantial surcharge, so please plan accordingly.

There are no weight limits or bag fees for the cruise itself.

Embarkation Day!

Getting to the Port in Port Canaveral

The easiest way to get to the port is with the NCL shuttle service, available from the Orlando Airport until 2 pm on January 22. If you're interested in this service, you should reserve by January 18 on the NCL website with your booking.

You can also use a taxi or ride-sharing service (Uber, Lyft, etc.), from the Orlando airport or area. The port is a 45-minute drive from the airport, and costs vary depending on the service, but is usually around \$60-70 per vehicle.

Parking is available for a rate of \$17.00 per day plus tax at the pier. Nearby services may be cheaper.

Important Check-In Time Information

Embarkation begins around 12:30pm, and we'll start check-in around noon. Check-in moves very, very quickly here if you're pre-registered with NCL.

All of you have been assigned a boarding time. Please honor this time to minimize the waiting time for all. It will take some time to test each of you and get everyone onboard. Your cooperation and patience is greatly appreciated.

Please note that you must be at the pier and checked in no later than 3 pm or you may be denied boarding.

Prima sails at 4 pm sharp on January 22!

What Do I Need to Check-In?

Since your reservation is electronic, all you need is a valid passport and a valid credit card to check-in for this cruise. You will then be issued a stateroom card, which will serve as your room key and identification card for boarding and reboarding the ship!

Prohibited Items

Please do not bring any of the following onboard, and do not place these items in your checked luggage: Irons (including travel irons), alcoholic beverages, knives, firearms, handcuffs, or any other potentially dangerous item. Items that look like something dangerous may also be confiscated as a precautionary measure.

If your luggage contains any of the above items, your bag will be held at

security and will not be delivered to your stateroom. Full details on prohibited items can be found on the Norwegian website.

Alcoholic Beverage and Other Restrictions

Norwegian does not allow alcoholic beverages to be brought aboard the ship for consumption during your vacation. Any alcohol brought onboard or purchased onboard will be held in secure storage and delivered to your stateroom on the last night of the cruise.

You may bring one bottle of wine or champagne per person to be consumed in the restaurants or stateroom with an \$15 corkage fee applied for each (750ml) bottle, payable upon embarkation. Lost Luggage Assistance

If your luggage does not arrive with you, please do all of the following:

1. Get a complete report from the airline, including a receipt and tracking number for your luggage. Make sure that you tell the airline that you are boarding Norwegian Prima.
2. Upon arrival on the ship, go immediately to guest relations where they will make a copy of your lost baggage report. The ship will attempt to track your luggage and follow up directly with the airlines.
3. Be patient. Depending on the airline it might arrive prior to sailing. Our port agents, in concert with the ship, will attempt to deliver any lost luggage directly to your room. If your luggage does not arrive, they will keep you informed with the latest news from your airline.

Please understand that neither Norwegian nor Atlantis has lost your luggage. We can only assist you in recovering your luggage from the airline and in communicating with them. Ultimately, the airline is responsible to you for any loss or inconvenience you encounter.

However, in our experience most bags turn up in the first 48 hours.

If You Are Delayed

If you miss the ship for some reason, please contact Norwegian immediately at 1-866-234-7350 and they will assist you in making arrangements to board in the next port of call. Please note that local authorities and regulations may restrict the ability for guests to embark or disembark in certain ports.

Atlantis Daily Program

Our office and volunteer Team Atlantis staff will be on hand throughout to host and assist with every aspect of your vacation. Please don't hesitate to ask any of us if you have a question or require assistance. We are available 24 hours a day, and always wear Atlantis name badges.

We also offer a general information desk located adjacent to Guest Services on Deck 7. Hours vary and are posted in *Freestyle Daily*.

Atlantis staff can also be reached through Guest Services at any time.

All dining times are approximate, and may change slightly according to our port times and onboard events.

Team Atlantis will be on hand at the main restaurant to seat you, answer questions, and host tables. We always encourage you to join our other guests for meals. It's the best way to meet people! Both Atlantis and NCL will do our best to honor special seating requests.

Please be patient during peak hours as there may be a slight wait in the main restaurant. We recommend dining before 8:00 pm or after 9:00 pm to avoid waiting in line. The best way to avoid waiting in line is to either dine before the first show or immediately afterwards, and we will always keep the main restaurant open at least 15 minutes after the early show ends.

What's Included?

Most meals and restaurants are included. The exceptions are specialty restaurants listed on the opposite page and in the next section. Coffee, tea, and most juices are also included. Specialty coffees, alcoholic beverages, soft drinks, bottled water are available at our bars and restaurants for an additional charge.

We suggest taking advantage of dining in a variety of venues and enjoying your meal times with friends old and new. It's the easiest and best way to connect!

Le Bistro is Prima's signature French restaurant with elegant interiors, crisp white linens and attentive servers.

Hasuki takes Hibachi to a new level as skillful chefs prepare dazzling creations on a steel grill before your eyes. It's a sizzling front row seat!

Cagney's sets the standard for an American steakhouse with premium cuts of certified Agnus Beef and classic cocktails.

Reservations are strongly advised, and may be made at any time throughout your cruise.. Each restaurant is equipped to handle parties no larger than eight (and only a few tables are this size), and larger groups will not be accepted. Please respect these policies so that the maximum number of our guests may enjoy these unique dining experiences. See Freestyle Daily for reservation times.

Tank tops and gym-like shorts are not permitted in these premium restaurants and we ask that you please respect this simple dress code.

An extra charge for dining applies in each venue.

Singles Dining

Traveling solo doesn't mean you have to eat alone. Whenever you enter our restaurants, our Team Atlantis will graciously seat you with our other guests. Also, we're creating two special singles dinners, along with a designated meeting place for single guests to gather for drinks before dinner. See Freestyle Daily for specific times and locations.

Special Diets

We ask that you submit any special dietary requests including allergies in writing directly to Norwegian prior to sailing. Once onboard, please speak with the Maitre D' of the restaurant regarding any special requests.

Please note that since this cruise is "open seating," it is your responsibility to notify the server and/or Maitre D' of any special requests you have made every time you dine.

Vegetarian and vegan options are available at each meal and need no special notification.

Room Service

Room service is available 24 hours a day. To have continental breakfast delivered to your stateroom, fill out the breakfast card included in your stateroom and hang it on the outside of your stateroom door prior to going to bed. Your continental breakfast will then be delivered the next morning at the time of your choosing. For all other times, follow the directions onboard.. The stateroom directory lists a complete menu of offerings. Some extra charges may apply.

Optional Beverage Packages

Norwegian will offer a wide range of beverage packages on our charter, including wine packages, and unlimited non-alcoholic packages. These packages can be booked online in advance under Indulgences at:

Personal Funds & Shipboard Charges

The currency on board is U.S. dollars. Norwegian ships operate on a cashless system. You can validate your Norwegian charge card with your Visa, MasterCard, Novus, or American Express card, or sign for payment by cash or traveler's check. Guests can then sign all on-board services and purchases to their account. At the end of the cruise, you will receive a completely itemized statement.

For your convenience, the ship has an on-board ATM machine that dispenses U.S. currency. Bank debit cards on the PLUS and CIRRUS networks and the following credit cards: American Express, Discover/Novus, MasterCard and VISA are accepted. Fees will be charged per transaction.

Room Features

Rooms on Prima are super comfortable, with all the modern amenities you'd expect on a premium cruise ship. The ship has both 110 (US standard) and 220 (European) voltage power outlets in the rooms. All the water onboard is filtered and potable. Each stateroom is equipped with a hair dryer.

Customs & Immigration at Sea

At each port of call, customs and immigration officials may board the ship and clear it before we are allowed to go ashore. Normally, this occurs without your knowledge or participation. Occasionally, passengers are called for inspection. In these cases, please follow the instructions provided to assure that we are able to disembark in a timely manner in each port.

Shore Excursion Notes

You can pre-book shore excursions in advance on the Norwegian web site (Ncl.com). Upon arrival to the ship, you will receive tickets for your pre-booked excursions in your stateroom. You may purchase additional shore excursions onboard, subject to availability, at the Shore Excursions Desk or through your TV set using the system in your room.

Atlantis has worked closely with Norwegian to enhance and develop excursions that will be fun and exciting for our group. Most of the excursions are "exclusive" to Atlantis guests. If you are in doubt, please inquire with shore excursions before booking.

Laundry & Dry Cleaning Services

Laundry, dry cleaning, spot removal, and pressing services are available for a reasonable fee. Laundry bags and service request forms are in your room. Ask your cabin steward for details. There are also no self-service laundry facilities onboard.

There are no irons in staterooms as they constitute a fire hazard. Please note that portable irons are not permitted for the same reasons.

Service Charges and Tipping

A mandatory service charge will be added to your account as detailed on our website. Currently the rate is \$20 per person per day for standard rooms and \$25 for Club Rooms and above. This charge goes directly to the cabin stewards, waiters, and other personnel to compensate them at levels that are customary for a sailing of this size. It is the same rate that all non-charter guests pay onboard.

No additional tipping to these service personnel is needed but may be extended at your discretion if the service is exceptional.

A 20% gratuity is automatically added to bar purchases and spa services.

Smoking Policy

For the comfort of all of our guests, designated smoking and non-smoking areas are available throughout the vessel. All interior spaces of the ship are non-smoking. Smoking is permitted only in specific outdoor areas, which will be detailed onboard. As a courtesy to our guests, ship personnel will thoroughly enforce the smoking policy.

If You Have a Problem or Question

Both the Guest Relations Desk and the Atlantis Desk can handle most any difficulty you may encounter. Generally, issues relating to your stateroom, the ship, schedules, or billing should be directed to the Guest Relations Desk. Questions regarding entertainment, service, special requests, or anything else should be directed to the Atlantis Desk. Questions about excursions should go directly to the Shore Excursions Desk.

If the Atlantis Desk is unattended, please feel free to ask any Team Atlantis member and they will assist you.

Important Guest Policy Notice

Please remember that all our guests are bound by Norwegian's Passenger Ticket Contract. The policy is intended to help ensure that all guests are able to participate in a safe and enjoyable cruise experience and sets forth standards of conduct for guests to follow throughout their vacation. Please take a minute to read the contract on their website.

Although we shouldn't have to say this, please remember that both Norwegian and Atlantis have a zero-tolerance policy towards all illegal substances and behavior that violates the above policy. Any violation could result in your vacation being terminated early, or worse.

If a guest is found in possession of an illegal substance, appropriate action

will be taken, which may include removal from the ship and involvement of appropriate authorities, which may result in prosecution. Guests removed from the ship pursuant to this policy are responsible for their own accommodations and transportation home, at their expense and no refund will be offered for the unused portion of your cruise.

Spa Services

Prima features an exceptional full-service spa, offering a wide range of services, including massage, facial, aromatherapy, hairstyling, and much more. Appointments for these services should be made early in your cruise, as many of the services book up early. All spa services are an additional charge which can be signed to your stateroom.

Spa appointments will open on embarkation day, immediately following the boat drill, in order to be fair to all our guests. Guests in Suites may reserve Spa appointments beginning at 3:00 pm.

Internet Access

Wireless Internet access is available aboard Prima for an additional charge. As you would expect, Internet speeds at sea are significantly slower than on land.

Packages will be available for purchase onboard in a variety of formulas. We recommend trying to unplug a bit -- after all, you are on vacation!

Mobile Phone Access

Norwegian offers an advanced cell phone roaming service that allows you to use your mobile phone in the same manner at an additional charge.

The Wireless Maritime Service system is available for use when the ship is in international waters. When your phone picks up the shipboard signal, it will usually display "cellular at sea," "Ship Roam," or "901-18." Depending on the type of mobile device you have and your carrier, you may be required to select "Roam" on the handset.

To avoid substantial and expensive roaming charges, we highly recommend setting your phone to "airplane" mode when at sea. For questions about your service or about billing, please contact your home network customer service.

Medical Services

Should you require medical attention while on board, an infirmity staff is available to assist you 24 hours a day. A doctor is available to render services at a customary charge. The infirmity is capable of providing treatment for minor matters which may arise during your cruise and are capable of assessing and stabilizing most medical emergencies. Should you require treatment for a serious condition which requires hospitalization, then arrangements may be made

to transfer you to a medical facility ashore. While at sea, the ability to transfer you to a shore side facility may be limited or delayed by weather or logistical considerations. If you are currently suffering from a serious medical condition, please consult with your personal physician prior to sailing. The onboard doctors are independent contractors.

Important Health Notice – Please Read!

If you should come down with a contagious disease, or even suspect a contagious disease, it's compulsory that you report it to the ship's infirmity for the safety of everyone on board. Should you be on any medication, or want the medical staff to be aware of any special needs, please contact the infirmity. This will ensure that they will be prepared should you need assistance.

In rare instances, the ship's medical staff may determine that your medical condition will require you to be quarantined in your stateroom to protect the health of our other guests. While both Norwegian and Atlantis will make every effort to make you comfortable in such a situation, we are unable to compensate lost vacation time due to quarantine.

Please note that the ship follows C.D.C. guidelines on all quarantine issues, and there is little flexibility in applying the rules, particularly where gastrointestinal symptoms are present.

As always, we highly recommend travel insurance to assist with unforeseen costs and reimbursement for missed vacation time due to illness. If you do not have travel insurance, it can be purchased virtually right up to departure time.

Please note that this includes COVID related quarantines and that since this sailing is a charter no credit or refund is issued for any lost time onboard. This is why we strongly recommend Travel Insurance!

Satellite Telephone Access

You can make ship-to-shore calls from your stateroom, 24 hours a day. The cost is \$7.95 per minute and will automatically be charged to your account.

Friends and family can reach you 24 hours a day via Norwegian's Satellite Service. Have them call 888-627-4477 from the USA, or 1-732-335-3280 from the rest of the world. The cost is \$7.95 per minute and can be billed to their American Express, MasterCard, or Discover cards. (From outside the U.S.A., additional long-distance charges will apply).

Cell Phone Access Onboard

Prima is equipped to allow your mobile phone to work onboard. Please note that roaming charges apply and will be billed directly by your home carrier. Rates vary by carrier but can be considerably cheaper than using the satellite phones. Check with your carrier prior to sailing for specific rates.

This access only works while at sea. When in port, the local land operator's roaming charges will apply. Again, check with your operator to see what roaming options exist.
