All arrival and departure times are approximate and may change without notice. Please note embarkation and departure times during your cruise at all gangways.

Itinerary Changes

Atlantis and Royal Caribbean have carefully planned this itinerary for maximum enjoyment in all our ports and onboard your ship. Although we do our best to adhere to published ports and times, unforeseen weather and/or sea conditions may force us to alter the itinerary during your cruise.

In the unlikely event of an itinerary change while sailing, we will communicate our new plan through ship-wide (outside of cabin) announcements and an updated *Cruise Compass*. According to your Passenger Cruise Contract, neither Atlantis nor Royal Caribbean shall be held liable for any damages resulting from any itinerary change.

Get Ready

Review Your Passport or Proof of Citizenship

To travel, a valid passport is preferred and required for all guests from outside the U.S.A. Proof of citizenship in the form of an original birth certificate and a government-issued photo ID is acceptable for U.S. citizens only. Visas are not required for citizens of the US and Canada. Visa requirements for all other nationalities vary and should be checked with the embassy or consulate of each country visited on your itinerary.

Please note that you must have the necessary documentation before boarding the ship. Failure to provide proper and valid documentation will result in denied boarding, and no refund will be provided.

Register On-line With Royal Caribbean Line

Please take a minute now to register online with Royal Caribbean. It only takes a minute, starting at the following link:

If you don't have one yet, you'll need to set up an account with Royal Caribbean. Additionally, you'll need to download the Royal Caribbean app to your mobile phone to complete the check-in process. Once you complete the online registration, the final details will remain in the app on your phone.

To Check-in, you will need the following:

- Royal Caribbean Booking Number (provided by email to you)
- Full legal name as Atlantis has it recorded
- Your Passport information
- Credit card to use for onboard purchases

If you are unable to complete online check-in, you will be required to complete check-in at the pier using manual forms. Don't worry as we'll get you there altough it may take a bit longer to process.

Get Ready

Review Your Flight Plans

This sounds obvious but take a minute right now and ensure your flights to Los Angeles are booked correctly.

Ensure you have enough time to depart correctly from the ship on October 30th. Your flight should not be booked before 11am.

Book Shore Excursions

You can pre-book shore excursions in advance on the Royal Caribbean website (<u>https://www.royalcaribbean.com</u>) until October 20th. Upon arrival to the ship, you will receive tickets for your prebooked excursions in your stateroom.

You may purchase additional shore excursions onboard, subject to availability, at the Shore Excursions Desk. You may also book shore excursions through your TV in your stateroom or using the Royal Caribbean App.

Atlantis has worked closely with Royal Caribbean to enhance and develop shore excursions that will be fun and exciting for our group. Virtually all these excursions are "exclusive" to Atlantis guests, although in very few cases, the tours may be mixed with guests from other cruise ships. If you are in doubt, please inquire with Shore Excursions before booking.



Before You Go

Packing Advice

Atlantis emphasizes a casual, comfortable atmosphere with no specified dress code. Sportswear and casual resort attire are always appropriate. There are no formal nights and no need for a jacket and tie.

The only real rule is that no tank tops or gym-type shorts are permitted in the specialty restaurants. These are a premium experience; we want to maintain a quality ambiance for all our guests. Thank you for understanding and cooperation on this one.

Plan for warm, even hot weather with slightly cooler breezes at night. It can also get cool on the first and last sailing days, so plan accordingly. We recommend loose, comfortable cotton and other lightweight clothing. Don't forget a hat!

Except for the above notes, our ports are very relaxed with few dress codes. We suggest casual resort wear and some comfortable shoes. Daytime at sea is time for swimwear and flip-flops. Bring lots of sunblock.

Currency Advice

The entire ship operates on U.S. Dollars on board; all our ports use the Mexican New Peso (MXN).

Mexican Peso (MXN) \$1 USD = \$MXN 17.90 (as of October 10th)

We strongly recommend using your ATM card to get the best rate of exchange for cash. Just be wary of bank fees. There are plenty of ATM machines throughout our ports. You'll get the best exchange by using a credit card for large purchases. Always select the "local currency" option when making purchases to avoid transaction fees.

Baggage Essentials

Most airlines, especially non-US airlines, limit checked bags and carry-on luggage. Check with your carrier for specific allowances. The standard limit is 50 pounds (23 kilos) per piece. Excess or overweight bags may incur a substantial surcharge, so please plan accordingly. There are no weight limits or bag fees for the cruise.

Prohibited Items

Please do not bring any of the following onboard, and do not place these items in your checked luggage: Irons (including travel irons), alcoholic beverages, knives, firearms, power strips, or any other potentially dangerous items.

If your luggage contains any of the above items, your bag will be held at security and will not be delivered to your stateroom. Full details on prohibited items can be found on the Royal Caribbean website.

Embarkation Day

Getting to The Port of Los Angeles

The cruise ship port of Los Angeles is in the San Pedro Bay. The pier is about 22 miles from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). The port address is:

World Cruise Center 100 E. Swinford St. San Pedro, CA 90731

For those of you flying into Los Angeles, we recommend taking a taxi or Uber from the airport to the ship.

Parking is available at the pier for \$20 per day.

Important Check-In Information

The ship will open for embarkation beginning around 12:30 pm, and we'll start check-in around Noon. Please do not arrive earlier than your scheduled time, as we need time to turn the ship around after the previous sailing.

When you register online, you'll be able to select an arrival window. Please adhere to the arrival window on your SetSail pass to keep crowding in the terminal at a minimum. Guests arriving on time will be given priority over guests who arrive earlier than scheduled.

Due to government regulations requiring cruise lines to submit final departure manifests at least 60 minutes prior to sailing, guests are requested to complete Online Check-in no later than 3 days prior to their cruise. If you have not completed Online Check-in, you must complete this process at the pier at least 90 minutes before the published sailing time.

Please note that you must be at the pier and checked in no later than 3 pm, or you may be denied boarding.

Navigator of the Seas sails at 4 pm sharp on October 23rd.

What Do I Need to Check-In?

Since your reservation is electronic, you only need your passport or proof of citizenship plus a credit card to check in for this cruise. When you arrive at your room, you'll find your SeaPass card, which will serve as your room key and identification card for boarding and re-boarding the ship!

Embarkation Day

Alcoholic Beverages and Other Restrictions

You are not allowed to bring beer or hard liquor onboard for consumption during your cruise. Alcoholic beverages seized on embarkation day will not be returned.

Guests wishing to bring personal wine and champagne onboard may do so only on boarding day, limited to two (2) 750 ml bottles per stateroom. Each bottle shall be subject to a corkage fee when consumed in a public area.

Additional bottles of wine beyond two (2) bottles that are brought onboard, or any alcoholic beverages purchased in ports of call or from shops on board will be stored by the ship and delivered to your stateroom on the last day of the sailing. Security may inspect containers (water bottles, soda bottles, mouthwash, luggage, etc.) and will dispose of containers holding alcohol. Guests who violate any alcohol policies may be disembarked or not allowed to board at their own expense, in accordance with the Royal Caribbean Guest Conduct Policy.

Lost Luggage Assistance

If your luggage does not arrive with you, please do all the following: 1. Get a complete report from the airline, including your luggage's receipt and tracking number. Make sure that you tell the airline that you are boarding *Navigator of the Seas*.

2. Upon arrival on the ship, go immediately to guest services, where they will make a copy of your lost baggage report. The ship will attempt to track your luggage and follow up directly with the airlines.

3. Be patient. Depending on the airline, it might arrive prior to sailing. Our port agents will attempt to deliver any lost luggage directly to your room in concert with the ship. If your luggage does not arrive, they will keep you informed with the latest news from your airline.

Please understand that neither Royal Caribbean nor Atlantis has lost your luggage. We can only assist you in recovering your luggage from the airline and in communicating with them. Ultimately, the airline is responsible to you for any loss or inconvenience you encounter. However, in our experience, most bags turn up in the first 48 hours.



Atlantis Daily Program

The Atlantis version of the *Navigator* daily program, called *Cruise Compass,* will be delivered to your stateroom each night with a complete schedule for the following day. All activities, shows, and event times are described here. Since this is our primary method of communicating with you, please read it daily.

If you don't feel like reading, take 5 minutes each morning to watch Ben's daily TV broadcast for a more entertaining look at the upcoming day's events.

Team & Information Desk

Our office and Team Atlantis staff will be on hand throughout to host and assist with every aspect of your vacation. Please don't hesitate to ask any of us if you have a question or require assistance. We are available 24 hours a day and always wear Atlantis name badges.

We also offer a general information desk located adjacent to Guest Services on Deck 5. Hours vary and are posted in *Cruise Compass*. Atlantis staff can also be reached through Guest Services at any time.

Dinner can be as quick or long as you wish, and there's no better way to meet our other guests than at a table in our main restaurants.

Specialty Restaurant Reservations

Navigator offers several distinctive and original dining experiences. Chops is an authentic steak house, with a warm club decor. Jamie's Italian features superb Italian food. The jewel box Hooked Seafood offers delicious seafood options. Izumi offers sushi and other Asian specialties in an inviting setting.

Reservations are strongly encouraged, and a limited number of bookings may be made in advance when you register online. We will hold approximately 30% of the seats for same-day bookings to allow flexibility for all guests.

Additionally, Royal Caribbean is offering some exceptional value on dining packages that allow you to eat big and save bigger with special deals on specialty restaurant experiences. See the cruise planner for details and we recommend booking in advance since offerings are limited.

Finally, please respect that we have limited space in these restaurants and a lot of guests want to enjoy them. If your plans change, please cancel your booking promptly so we can accommodate another guest. Also, please respect your original request in terms of table size (don't show up with 8 guests when you book for 4!). Thank you.

Tank tops and gym-like shorts are not permitted in these premium restaurants, and we ask that you please respect this simple dress code.

An extra charge for dining applies in each venue, including gratuity.

Room Service

Room service is available 24 hours a day. See the menu in your stateroom for a complete selection and ordering instructions and note that some selections and delivery times have an extra charge. Please recognize that the staff handling room service has limited capabilities. If you're looking for a quick snack, we highly recommend Cafe Promenade, open 24 hours a day.

Singles Dining

Traveling solo doesn't mean you have to eat alone. Whenever you enter our restaurants, our Team Atlantis will graciously seat you with our other guests. We've also created a designated meeting place for single guests to gather for drinks before dinner. See *Cruise Compass* for specific times and locations.

Special Diets

We ask that you submit any special dietary requests, including allergies in writing directly to Royal Caribbean prior to sailing. Once onboard, please speak with the restaurant's Maitre D' regarding any special requests. Please note that since this cruise is "open seating," you must notify the server and/or Maitre D' of any special requests each time you dine. Vegetarian options are available at each meal and need no advance notification.



Click on Your Upcoming Reservation by clicking your name on the web page's top right corner.

After that, choose "**View/Modify**" under your *Navigator* Cruise reservation. You will then be directed to your reservation summary, with "Add More Options" available at the bottom of the page.

From there, click **Add Drink Tickets**, and you will be able to purchase drink tickets accordingly.

A few restrictions apply, and Royal's standard 18% gratuity is added to the coupon book at the time of purchase. The rates on our website are the same as you will pay onboard, but onboard, it will take a lot longer to get the packages! Please note that packages cannot be refunded once purchased, and unused tickets have no value after the cruise.



Personal Funds & Shipboard Charges

The currency onboard is U.S. dollars. Royal Caribbean ships operate on a cashless system. You can validate your Royal Caribbean SeaPass card with your Visa, MasterCard, Discover/Novus, or American Express card or sign for payment by cash or traveler's check. Guests can then sign all onboard services and purchases to their account. You will receive a completely itemized statement at the end of the cruise.

For your convenience, the ship has an onboard ATM machine that dispenses U.S. currency. Bank debit cards on the PLUS and CIRRUS networks are accepted along with the following credit cards: American Express, Discover/Novus, MasterCard, and VISA. Fees will be charged per transaction.

Customs & Immigration at Sea

Upon embarkation and at each port of call, customs and immigration officials will inspect our guests and the ship. They must clear it before we are allowed to go ashore. Normally, this occurs without your knowledge or participation.

Occasionally, passengers are called for inspection. In these cases, please follow the instructions provided to ensure that we can disembark in a timely manner at each port.

While we shouldn't have to say this, please don't even think of bringing any type of illegal substance, hazardous material, or other items that customs or ship. Any guest found with illegal substances of any kind will be removed from the ship at the next port of call and turned over to local authorities.

Atlantis and Royal Caribbean both have a zero-tolerance policy for all illegal substances.

Guest Conduct Policy

Please remember that all our guests are bound by Royal Caribbean's Guest Conduct Policy. The policy is intended to help ensure that all guests can participate in a safe and enjoyable cruise experience and sets forth standards of conduct for guests to follow throughout their vacation. Please take a minute to read this policy on the Royal Caribbean website:

Guest Conduct Policy

Room Features

Navigator of the Seas rooms are truly state-of-the-art in every way. The ship has both 110 (US standard) and 220/230 (European) voltage power outlets in the rooms. All the water onboard is filtered and potable.

Each stateroom is equipped with an in-room safe, private bath with shower and vanity area, hair dryer, and interactive TV and movies, and phone. The interactive TV system offers a wide range of on-demand movies, as well as Atlantis programming and popular satellite channels. In addition, you can review your account and order room service. We recommend familiarizing yourself with this system when you embark, as it can save hours of standing in line!

Laundry & Dry-Cleaning Services

Laundry, dry cleaning, spot removal, and pressing services are available for an additional fee. Laundry bags and service request forms are in your room. Ask your cabin steward for details.

There are no irons in staterooms as they constitute a fire hazard. There are also no self-service laundry facilities onboard.

Service Charges and Tipping

A mandatory service charge will be added to each guest's onboard account as detailed on the Atlantis website at the time of booking. Currently, the rate is \$112.50 per person for standard cabins and \$129.50 for suites. Rates are subject to change at Royal Caribbean's discretion. Any changes to rate would be the same as to Royal Caribbean's non-charter clients.

All cabin stewards, waiters, and other personnel have been compensated at levels that are customary for a charter of this size. No additional tipping to these service personnel is needed but may be extended at your discretion if the service is exceptional.

An 18% mandatory gratuity is automatically added to bar purchases and spa services.

Smoking Policy

For the comfort of all of our guests, all indoor areas on the ship are non-smoking. Smoking is permitted only in designated outdoor areas of the starboard/or port side of the ship. As a courtesy to our guests, ship personnel will thoroughly enforce the smoking policy. Smoking is never allowed on any stateroom balcony.

Please note that Atlantis and/or Royal Caribbean reserves the right to change the smoking policy at any time depending on guest requirements. Upon embarkation in the *Cruise Compass*, a complete detail of the smoking areas onboard can be found in your stateroom.

If You Have a Problem or Question

Both the Guest Relations Desk and the Atlantis Information Desk can handle most difficulties you may encounter. Generally, issues relating to your stateroom, the ship, schedules, or billing should be directed to the Guest Relations Desk. Questions regarding entertainment, service, Atlantis policies, special requests, or anything else should be directed to the Atlantis Desk. Questions about excursions should go directly to the Shore Excursions Desk. If the Atlantis Desk is unattended, please feel free to ask any Team Atlantis member, and we will happily assist you.

Spa and Fitness Center

Navigator features an exceptional full-service spa offering a fantastic range of services, including massage, facials, aromatherapy, hairstyling, and much more. Appointments for these services should be made early in your cruise, as many of the services book up early. All spa services are an additional charge, which can be signed to your stateroom.

Stateroom Safe

All staterooms and suites are equipped with a personal safe. We recommend that you not leave valuables, jewelry, or money unsecured in your stateroom. Although every effort is made to safeguard staterooms, Royal Caribbean Cruises will not accept any responsibility for the loss or damage of any valuables left unsecured.

If you are participating in the roommate share program, please discuss the use of your safe with your roommate. No additional safes can be provided.

Medical Services

If you require medical attention while on board, an infirmary staff can assist you 24 hours a day. A doctor is available to render services at a customary charge. The infirmary can provide treatment for minor matters that may arise during your cruise and can assess and stabilize most medical emergencies. Should you require treatment for a serious condition requiring hospitalization, arrangements may be made to transfer you to a medical facility ashore. While at sea, the ability to transfer you to a shoreside facility may be limited or delayed by weather or logistical considerations. If you are currently suffering from a serious medical condition, please consult your physician before sailing Royal Caribbean's doctors are independent contractors.

Important Health Notice -- Please Read!

If you should come down with a contagious disease or even suspect a contagious disease, it's compulsory that you report it to the ship's infirmary for the safety of everyone on board. Should you be on any medication or want the medical staff to be aware of any special needs, please contact the infirmary. This will ensure that they will be prepared should you need assistance.

In rare instances, the ship's medical staff may determine that your medical condition will require you to be quarantined in your stateroom to protect the health of our other guests. While both Royal Caribbean and Atlantis will make every effort to make you comfortable in such a situation, we are unable to compensate lost vacation time due to quarantine.

Please note that the ship follows C.D.C. guidelines on all quarantine issues, and there is little flexibility in applying the rules, particularly where gastrointestinal symptoms are present.

As always, we highly recommend travel insurance to assist with unforeseen costs and reimbursement for missed vacation time due to illness. If you do not have travel insurance, it can be purchased virtually right up to departure time. Please note that this includes COVID-related quarantines and that since this sailing is a charter, no credit or refund is issued for any lost time. This is why we strongly recommend Travel Insurance!

Satellite Telephone Access

You can make ship-to-shore calls from your stateroom 24 hours a day. A per-minute charge applies and will automatically be charged to your SeaPass account.

Friends and family can reach you 24 hours a day via Royal Caribbean's Satellite Service. Have them call 888-724-SHIP (7447) from the USA. Those located outside the USA can call +(their country code) 1 32 1953 9003. The cost can be billed to their American Express, MasterCard, or Discover cards. (From outside the U.S.A., additional longdistance charges will apply).

Internet Access—Voom!

Navigator offers the fastest ship-wide internet access at sea for an additional fee. Every stateroom has wireless access, as do most public areas throughout the ship. Connection fees apply with a range of packages available either in advance or onboard. VOOM is amazing, and you won't know you're even at sea!

Cell Phone Access Onboard

Navigator is equipped to allow your mobile phone to work onboard. Please note that roaming charges apply and will be billed directly by your home carrier. Rates vary by carrier but are considerably cheaper than using satellite phones. Check with your carrier prior to sailing for specific rates. This access only works while at sea. When in port, the local land operator's roaming charges will apply. Again, check with your operator to see what roaming options exist.



Disembarkation

Upon arriving in Los Angeles after your cruise, we will begin disembarkation around 8 am. This procedure generally takes two hours. If you have a flight earlier than 11am, please notify Royal Caribbean onboard, and we'll do our best to prioritize your departure.

Transfers to the Los Angeles Airport (LAX) will be available for purchase during your cruise from Guest Services. We highly recommend the group transfer if you are flyiing directly home after the cruise.

After leaving the ship you may claim your luggage on the pier. Lost or damaged baggage must be reported to Royal Caribbean before leaving baggage claim.
