Please note that due to pier damage in San Juan, Royal Caribbean has replaced this port with St. Thomas and we thank you for your understanding.

Atlantis and Royal Caribbean have carefully planned this itinerary for maximum enjoyment in all our ports and onboard your ship. Although we do our best to adhere to published ports and times, unforeseen weather and/or sea conditions may force us to alter the itinerary during your cruise.

In the unlikely event of an itinerary change while sailing, we will communicate our new plan through ship-wide (outside of cabin) announcements and an updated *Cruise Compass*. According to your Passenger Cruise Contract, neither Atlantis nor Royal Caribbean shall be held liable for any damages resulting from any itinerary change.



Get Ready for Atlantis

Review Your Passport or Proof of Citizenship

To travel, a valid passport is preferred and required for all guests from outside the U.S.A. Proof of citizenship in the form of an original birth certificate and a government-issued photo ID is acceptable for U.S. citizens only. Visas are not required for citizens of the US and Canada. Visa requirements for all other nationalities vary and should be checked with the embassy or consulate of each country visited on your itinerary. Your passport should have an expiration date no earlier than Aug 10th, 2025.

Please note that you must have the necessary documentation before boarding the ship. Failure to provide proper and valid documentation will result in denied boarding, and no refund will be provided.

Register On-line With Royal Caribbean Line

Please take a minute now to register online with Royal Caribbean. It only takes a minute, starting at the following link:

If you don't have one yet, you'll need to set up an account with Royal Caribbean. Additionally, you'll need to download the Royal Caribbean app to your mobile phone to complete the check-in process. Once you complete the online registration, the final details will remain in the app on your phone.

To Check-in, you will need the following:

- Royal Caribbean Booking Number (provided by email to you)
- Your legal first & last names as Atlantis has them recorded
- Your Passport information
- Credit card to use for onboard purchases

If you are unable to complete online check-in, you will be required to complete check-in at the pier. Don't worry as we'll get you there although it may take a bit longer to process.

Get Ready for Atlantis

Review Your Flight Plans

This sounds obvious but take a minute right now and ensure your flights to Miami are booked correctly.

Ensure you have enough time to depart correctly from the ship on February 10th. Your flight should not be booked before 11 am from Miami and no earlier than noon if you're flying from Ft. Lauderdale.

Book Shore Excursions

You can pre-book shore excursions in advance on the Royal Caribbean website (<u>https://www.royalcaribbean.com</u>) until January 30th. Upon arrival to the ship, you will receive tickets for your prebooked excursions in your stateroom.

You may purchase additional shore excursions onboard, subject to availability, at the Shore Excursions Desk. You may also book shore excursions through your TV in your stateroom or using the Royal Caribbean App.

Atlantis has worked closely with Royal Caribbean to enhance and develop shore excursions that will be fun and exciting for our group. Virtually all these excursions are "exclusive" to Atlantis guests, although in very few cases, the tours may be mixed with guests from other cruise ships. If you are in doubt, please inquire with Shore Excursions before booking.

Show Tickets and Bookings

We are currently loading our entertainment program into the Royal Caribbean application, which you can use to book reservations for most of our shows once onboard. Many of our shows are ticketed, so take some time upon embarkation to review the week's schedule and book accordingly. Some shows will undoubtedly be in high demand, so we strongly encourage planning ahead.

We will be monitoring show reservations closely on the first day and if needed will add performances of our popular shows.



Before You Go

Packing Advice

Atlantis emphasizes a casual, comfortable atmosphere with no specified dress code. Sportswear and casual resort attire are always appropriate. There are no formal nights and no need for a jacket and tie.

The only real rule is that no tank tops or gym-type shorts are permitted in the specialty restaurants. These are a premium experience; we want to maintain a quality ambiance for all our guests. Thank you for your understanding.

Plan for warm, even hot weather with slightly cooler breezes at night. It can also get cool on the first and last sailing days, so plan accordingly. We recommend loose, comfortable cotton and other lightweight clothing. Don't forget a hat!

Except for the above notes, our ports are very relaxed with few dress codes. We suggest casual resort wear and some comfortable shoes. Daytime at sea calls for swimwear and flip-flops. Bring lots of sunblock.

Currency Advice

The entire ship operates on U.S. Dollars. There is absolutely no need to exchange money or bring local currency.

St. Maarten uses Euros, but virtually everywhere accepts US Dollars The current exchange rate is approximately \$1.05 USD per Euro.

Always select the "local currency" option when making purchases to avoid transaction fees.

Baggage Essentials

Most airlines, especially non-US airlines, limit checked bags and carry-on luggage. Check with your carrier for specific allowances. The standard limit is 50 pounds (23 kilos) per piece. Excess or overweight bags may incur a substantial surcharge, so please plan accordingly. There are no weight limits or bag fees for the cruise.

Prohibited Items

Please do not bring any of the following onboard, and do not place these items in your checked luggage: Irons (including travel irons), alcoholic beverages, knives, firearms, power strips, steam irons, or any other potentially dangerous items.

If your luggage contains any of the above items, your bag will be held at security and will not be delivered to your stateroom. Full details on prohibited items can be found on the Royal Caribbean website.

Embarkation Day

Getting to The Port of Miami

We will sail from Terminal A in Miami. Port of Miami – Dodge Island Royal Caribbean - Terminal A 1015 N. America Way Miami, FL 33132

The easiest way to get to the port is by taxi or ride-sharing (Uber, Lyft, etc.), all of which are readily available at the Miami airport. The port is a 15-minute cab ride from the airport, and costs about \$25, depending on the service.

Covered parking is available starting from \$25 per day at the pier. Nearby services may be cheaper.

For driving directions to the Port of Miami, please see your Royal Caribbean cruise documents.

Important Check-In Information

The ship will open for embarkation beginning around noon, and we'll start check-in around 11:30 am. Please do not arrive earlier than your scheduled time, as we need time to turn the ship around after the previous sailing.

When you register online, you'll be able to select an arrival window. Please adhere to the arrival window on your SetSail pass to keep crowding in the terminal at a minimum. Guests arriving on time will be given priority over guests who arrive earlier than scheduled.

Due to government regulations requiring cruise lines to submit final departure manifests at least 60 minutes prior to sailing, guests are requested to complete Online Check-in no later than 3 days prior to their cruise. If you have not completed Online Check-in, you must complete this process at the pier at least 90 minutes before the published sailing time.

Please note that you must be at the pier and checked in no later than 4 pm, or you may be denied boarding.

Allure of the Seas sails at 4:40 pm sharp on February 3.

What Do I Need to Check-In?

Since your reservation is electronic, you only need your passport or proof of citizenship plus a credit card to check in for this cruise. When you arrive at your room, you'll find your SeaPass card, which will serve as your room key and identification card for boarding and re-boarding the ship!

Embarkation Day

Alcoholic Beverages and Other Restrictions

You are not allowed to bring beer or hard liquor onboard for consumption during your cruise. Alcoholic beverages seized on embarkation day will not be returned.

Guests wishing to bring personal wine and champagne onboard may do so only on boarding day, limited to two (2) 750 ml bottles per stateroom. Each bottle shall be subject to a corkage fee when consumed in a public area.

Additional bottles of wine beyond two (2) bottles that are brought onboard, or any alcoholic beverages purchased in ports of call or from shops on board will be stored by the ship and delivered to your stateroom on the last day of the sailing. Security may inspect containers (water bottles, soda bottles, mouthwash, luggage, etc.) and will dispose of containers holding alcohol. Guests who violate any alcohol policies may be disembarked or not allowed to board at their own expense, in accordance with the Royal Caribbean Guest Conduct Policy.

Large quantities of non-alcoholic beverages (more than 2 bottles) are also not permitted to be brought onboard, including bottled water, sports drinks, and other beverages. Any beverages removed at security will not be returned.

Lost Luggage Assistance

If your luggage does not arrive with you, please do all the following:

1. Get a complete report from the airline, including your luggage's receipt and tracking number. Make sure that you tell the airline that you are boarding *Allure of the Seas*.

2. Upon arrival on the ship, go immediately to guest services, where they will make a copy of your lost baggage report. The ship will attempt to track your luggage and follow up directly with the airlines.

3. Be patient. Depending on the airline, your luggage might arrive prior to sailing. Our port agents will attempt to deliver any lost luggage directly to your room in concert with the ship. If your luggage does not arrive, they will keep you informed with the latest news from your airline.

Please understand that neither Royal Caribbean nor Atlantis has lost your luggage. We can only assist you in recovering your luggage from the airline and in communicating with them. Ultimately, the airline is responsible for any loss or inconvenience you encounter. However, in our experience, most bags turn up in the first 48 hours.

Atlantis Daily Program

The Atlantis version of the *Allure* daily program, called the *Cruise Compass*, will be delivered to your stateroom each night with a complete schedule for the following day. All activities, shows, and event times are described here. Since this is our primary method of communicating with you, please read it daily.

If you don't feel like reading, take 5 minutes each morning to watch Ben's daily TV broadcast for a more entertaining look at the upcoming day's events.

Team & Information Desk

Our office and Team Atlantis staff will be on hand throughout your vacation to host and assist with every aspect of your vacation. Please don't hesitate to ask any of us if you have a question or require assistance. We are available 24 hours a day and always wear Atlantis name badges.

We also offer a general information desk located adjacent to Guest Services on Deck 5. Hours vary and are posted in *Cruise Compass*. Atlantis staff can also be reached through Guest Services at any time.

Any guest who posts an explicit and publicly visible photo or video will be asked to leave the ship with no refund. Thank you for understanding and keeping Atlantis friendly!

If you are participating in our room share program, you have been assigned a roommate based on smoking preferences. Your roommate's name may appear on your confirmation; however, it is subject to change. This program is offered as a convenience and service for our single travelers, and as such, no roommate changes are permitted for any reason whatsoever.

How it Works

Atlantis and Royal Caribbean are presenting more productions, acts, and cabaret shows this week than ever before. Show Reservations and Tickets

Tank tops and gym-like shorts are not permitted in these premium restaurants, and we ask that you please respect this simple dress code.

An extra charge for dining applies in each venue, including gratuity.

And You Get One Dinner On Us!

When you pick up your drink ticket book, you'll also receive a personalized voucher valid for lunch or dinner at one of Allure's sensational specialty restaurants.

Reservations must be made to use your voucher and booking can only be made with the rules below. Please note that the vouchers may not be used for bookings made online prior to sailing as these must be prepaid in advance.

In order to accommodate everyone's vouchers fairly, the following rules apply:

1. Bookings can only be made onboard for same and next day dining using the vouchers.

2. Vouchers are only valid the first five days of the cruise. We strongly recommend using them on the first two nights.

3. Bookings are first-come, first served.

4. Vouchers are personalized and not transferable to another guest. Each account can only have one voucher credit on it for the sailing.

5. Vouchers have no cash value and expire if unused.

Personal Funds & Shipboard Charges

The currency onboard is U.S. dollars. Royal Caribbean ships operate on a cashless system. You can validate your Royal Caribbean SeaPass card with your Visa, MasterCard, Discover/Novus, or American Express card or sign for payment by cash or traveler's check. Guests can then sign all onboard services and purchases to their account. You will receive a fully itemized statement at the end of the cruise.

For your convenience, the ship has an onboard ATM machine that dispenses U.S. currency. Bank debit cards on the PLUS and CIRRUS networks are accepted along with the following credit cards: American Express, Discover/Novus, MasterCard, and VISA. Fees will be charged per transaction.

Customs & Immigration at Sea

Upon embarkation and at each port of call, customs and immigration officials will inspect our guests and the ship. They must clear it before we are allowed to go ashore. Normally, this occurs without your knowledge or participation.

Occasionally, passengers are called for inspection. In these cases, please follow the instructions provided to ensure that we can disembark in a timely manner at each port.

While we shouldn't have to say this, illegal substances, weapons, hazardous materials, or other restricted items are strictly prohibited. Any guest found with illegal substances of any kind will be removed from the ship at the next port of call and turned over to local authorities.

Atlantis and Royal Caribbean both have a zero-tolerance policy for all illegal substances.

Guest Conduct Policy

Please remember that all our guests are bound by Royal Caribbean's Guest Conduct Policy. The policy is intended to help ensure that all guests can participate in a safe and enjoyable cruise experience and sets forth standards of conduct for guests to follow throughout their vacation. Guest Conduct Policy

Room Features

Allure of the Seas rooms are truly state-of-the-art in every way. The ship has both 110 (US standard) and 220/230 (European) voltage power outlets in the rooms. All the water onboard is filtered and potable.

Each stateroom is equipped with an in-room safe, private bath with shower and vanity area, hair dryer, and interactive TV and movies, and phone. The interactive TV system offers a wide range of on-demand movies, as well as Atlantis programming and popular satellite channels. In addition, you can review your account and order room service. We recommend familiarizing yourself with this system when you embark, as it can save hours of standing in line!

Laundry & Dry-Cleaning Services

Laundry, dry cleaning, spot removal, and pressing services are available for an additional fee. Laundry bags and service request forms are in your room. Ask your cabin steward for details.

There are no irons in staterooms as they constitute a fire hazard. There are also no self-service laundry facilities onboard.

Service Charges and Tipping

Standard Service Charges are pre-paid with your cruise fare.

All cabin stewards, waiters, and other personnel have been compensated at levels that are customary for a charter of this size. No additional tipping to these service personnel is needed but may be extended at your discretion if the service is exceptional.

An 18% mandatory gratuity is automatically added to bar purchases and spa services.

Smoking & Vaping Policy

For the comfort of all of our guests, all indoor areas on the ship are non-smoking. Smoking and vaping is permitted only in designated outdoor areas of the starboard or port side of the ship. As a courtesy to our guests, ship personnel will thoroughly enforce the smoking policy. Smoking is never allowed on any stateroom balcony.

Please note that Atlantis and/or Royal Caribbean reserves the right to change the smoking policy at any time depending on guest requirements. Upon embarkation in the *Cruise Compass*, a complete detail of the smoking areas onboard can be found in your stateroom.

If You Have a Problem or Question

Both the Guest Relations Desk and the Atlantis Information Desk can handle most issues you may encounter. Generally, issues relating to your stateroom, the ship, schedules, or billing should be directed to the Guest Relations Desk. Questions regarding entertainment, service, Atlantis policies, special requests, or anything else should be directed to the Atlantis Desk. Questions about excursions should go directly to the Shore Excursions Desk. If the Atlantis Desk is unattended, please feel free to ask any Team Atlantis member, and we will happily assist you.

Spa and Fitness Center

Allure features an exceptional full-service spa offering a fantastic range of services, including massage, facials, aromatherapy, hairstyling, and much more. Appointments for these services should be made early in your cruise, as many of the services book up early. All spa services are an additional charge, which can be signed to your stateroom.

Stateroom Safe

All staterooms and suites are equipped with a personal safe. We recommend that you not leave valuables, jewelry, or money unsecured in your stateroom. Although every effort is made to safeguard staterooms, Royal Caribbean Cruises will not accept any responsibility for the loss or damage of any valuables left unsecured.

If you are participating in the roommate share program, please discuss the use of your safe with your roommate. No additional safes can be provided.

Medical Services

If you require medical attention while on board, an infirmary staff can assist you 24 hours a day. A doctor is available to provide care at a customary charge. The infirmary can provide treatment for minor matters that may arise during your cruise and can assess and stabilize most medical emergencies. Should you require treatment for a serious condition requiring hospitalization, arrangements may be made to transfer you to a medical facility ashore. While at sea, the ability to transfer you to a shore side facility may be limited or delayed by weather or logistical considerations. If you are currently suffering from a serious medical condition, please consult your physician before sailing. Royal Caribbean's doctors are independent contractors.

Our Care Team

Atlantis and Royal Caribbean want you to have lots of fun in a safe and enjoyable environment throughout your journey onboard *Allure of the Seas*. Given the large numbers of people enjoying our parties and events, we've decided to bring some additional team members to supplement the superb onboard staff of *Allure*.

Our Care Team is here to help! You'll find a team of dedicated medical professionals at all our parties and events here to assist with absolutely anything. They will be wearing bright blue T-shirts with our Care Team logo, and all have experience in working large festivals, sports events, and nightlife.

If you or anybody around you needs assistance or might need medical care, please simply ask them. They will provide support in a nonjudgmental manner regardless of the situation. All matters are handled in the same ethical manner as in a land-based hospital.

Most importantly, please look after yourselves and each other. Please let our team assist first if you see somebody who over-indulges or is unwell. Enjoy yourselves, but remember to take breaks to eat, sleep, and hydrate! Most people don't realize how different being at sea is and how the combination of motion, sun, and late hours can sneak up on you. Take a night off once in a while and explore the myriad of options we have planned for you! You are here on vacation, and we truly want you to go home feeling rested, not exhausted.

Important Health Notice -- Please Read!

If you should come down with a contagious disease or even suspect a contagious disease, it's compulsory that you report it to the ship's infirmary for the safety of everyone on board. Should you be on any medication or want the medical staff to be aware of any special needs, please contact the infirmary. This will ensure that they will be prepared should you need assistance.

In rare instances, the ship's medical staff may determine that your medical condition will require you to be quarantined in your stateroom to protect the health of our other guests. While both Royal Caribbean and Atlantis will make every effort to make you comfortable in such a situation, we are unable to compensate lost vacation time due to quarantine.

Please note that the ship follows C.D.C. guidelines on all quarantine issues, and there is little flexibility in applying the rules, particularly where gastrointestinal symptoms are present.

As always, we highly recommend travel insurance to assist with unforeseen costs and reimbursement for missed vacation time due to illness. If you do not have travel insurance, it can be purchased virtually right up to departure time. Please note that this includes COVID-related quarantines and that since this sailing is a charter, no credit or refund is issued for any lost time. This is why we strongly recommend travel insurance!

Satellite Telephone Access

You can make ship-to-shore calls from your stateroom 24 hours a day. A per-minute charge applies and will automatically be charged to your SeaPass account.

Friends and family can reach you 24 hours a day via Royal Caribbean's Satellite Service. Have them call 888-724-SHIP (7447) from the USA. Those located outside the USA can call +(their country code) 1 32 1953 9003. The cost can be billed to their American Express, MasterCard, or Discover cards. (From outside the U.S.A., additional longdistance charges will apply).

Internet Access—Voom!

Allure offers the fastest ship-wide internet access at sea for an additional fee. Every stateroom has wireless access, as do most public areas throughout the ship. Connection fees apply with a range of packages available either in advance or onboard. VOOM is amazing, and you won't know you're even at sea!

Cell Phone Access Onboard

Allure is equipped to allow your mobile phone to work onboard. Please note that roaming charges apply and will be billed directly by your home carrier. Rates vary by carrier but are considerably cheaper than using satellite phones. Check with your carrier prior to sailing for specific rates. This access only works while at sea. When in port, the local land operator's roaming charges will apply. Again, check with your carrier for available roaming options.
